

## **Nomination Form**

The Columbia College Classified Senate has developed two distinct methods of recognizing, articulating and valuing the professionalism and contributions of classified staff to Columbia College. These awards are representative of the Classified Senate's active role in the participatory governance process.

Approved by the Classified Senate and supported by the College President, the Classified Staff STAR Award will be presented to a fellow Classified Employee from the Classified Senate in acknowledgment of an <u>outstanding action or endeavor by the recipient going above and beyond usual duties</u> in meeting challenges in the work area, advancing the mission of Columbia College with innovative ideas, or representing the Classified Staff in an exceptionally superior way.

The STAR Award differs from the Employee of the Year Award in the following ways:
