Dear Candidate:

Student leaders are learners, mentors and motivators. They help foster relationships between faculty, staff, students and organizations. Student leaders are the face of the college in the public sector, and the community at large. Congratulations on your decision to run for Executive Office or as a Senator. Please read this Election code carefully and follow it honestly while completing all the required forms within the allotted time. All prospective candidates must meet all guidelines needed to hold office.

In the Elections Candidate Packet you will find information that is vital to running for an elected office. Please read this packet and the ASCC Constitution & Bylaws carefully.

Also, remember that as a candidate you are responsible for the actions of anyone campaigning on your behalf, so make sure that all of your campaign staff is familiar with this information.

Office Requirements for ASCC Officers:

The President of ASCC, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Director of Activities, Director of Publicity, and Director of Club Affairs shall have received course credit for a minimum of nine (9) units the semester before, and be enrolled in nine (9) units during his or her term of office with a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative GPA. A 2.0 semester GPA must be maintained during the entire term of office.

Office Requirements for Senators:

All Senators and Standing Committee Chairs shall be members of the ASCC and will have received course credit for a minimum of nine (9) units the semester before, and during his or her term of office with a minimum of a 2.5 cumulative GPA. A 2.0 semester GPA must be maintained during the entire term of office.
