Dear Candidate:

Congratulations on your decision to run for Executive Office or as a Senator. Please read this Election code carefully and follow it honestly while completing all the required forms within the allotted time. All prospective candidates must meet all guidelines need to hold office.

Office Requirements for ASCC Officers:

The President of ASCC, Vice-President of ASCC, Treasurer, Secretary, Director of Activities, Director of Publicity, and Director of Clubs Affairs shall be members of the ASCC. They will have received course credit for a minimum of nine (9) units the semester before, and be enrolled in nine (9) units during his or her term of office with a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA. A 2.0 semester GPA must be maintained during the entire term of office. Officers shall be required to hold posted office hours to total Three (3) hours per week.

Office Requirements for Senators:

All Senators shall be a member of ASCC and will have received course credit for a minimum of nine (9) units the semester before, and during his or her term of office with a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA. New students will not be held to the nine units prior to taking office requirements if the Executive Council or the advisor when there is no Executive Council, have the right to waive these requirements. A 2.0 semester GPA must be maintained during the entire term of office. Senators of the ASCC shall be required to hold posted office hours to total three (3) hours per week.
