The Financial Aid Office establishes (within Federal, State, and regional guidelines) modest budgets that reflect the average student's costs for a nine-month period. Taken into consideration are a variety of conditions, such as living accommodations and special additional costs.

Standard student budgets are constructed recognizing different costs for three categories of students. Those living at home, those living away from home, and those attending less than half-time (less than half-time budgets are used to determine Federal Pell eligibility only).
