- **Homeless:** lacking a fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence, which includes living in shelters, motels or cars, or temporarily living with other people because there was nowhere else to go.
- Youth: 23 years of age or younger or are still enrolled in high school as of the day you signed your financial aid application.

	 At any time on or after July 1, 2023, were you considered to be homeless? What were your (and parents) living arrangements over the past year? With whom have you resided? Who has provided support to you during the past year? What is the nature of your contact with your parent(s) or guardian(s)? 	
	2. A signed statement from an official source (on letterhead whenever possible) who can attest to your living situation from first-hand knowledge. This may include the adult whose home you are temporarily living in, a counselor, employer, religious leader, medical professional, social worker, etc.
