1. Getting Started

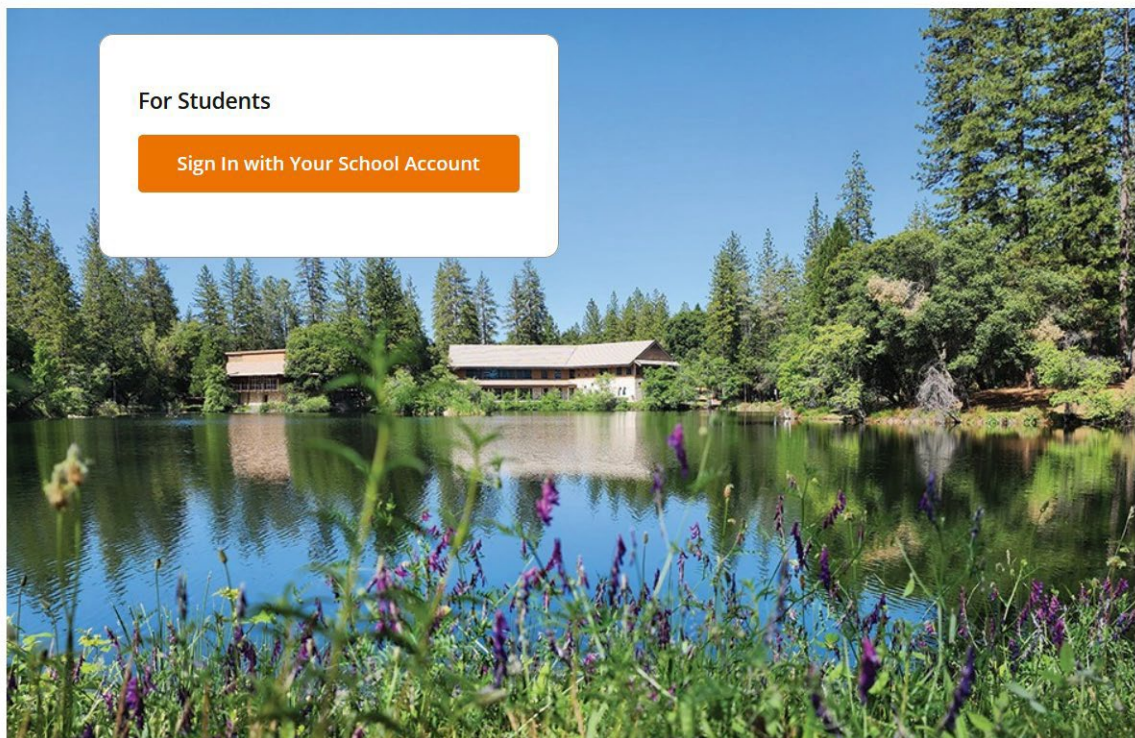
- Visit the Columbia College Scholarship website:

- Click the *Sign in with your School Account* button and **sign in using your student email credentials**.

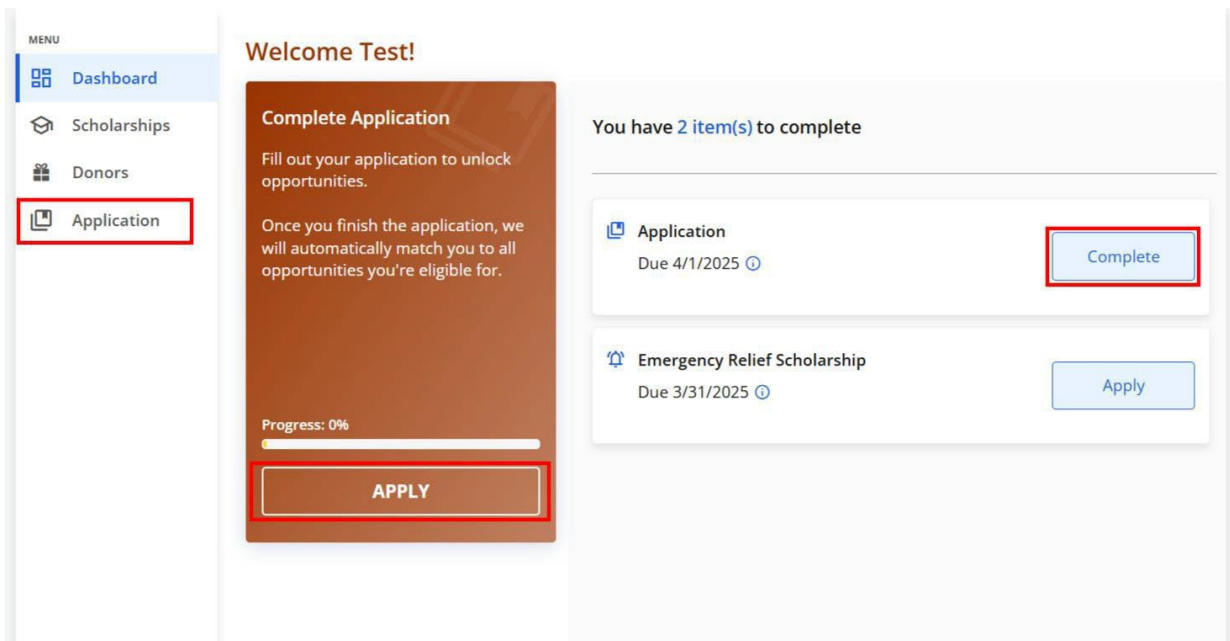


2. Dashboard Overview

Once you log in, you'll land on your Dashboard, which shows:

- The status of your application
- Any tasks or additional instructions
- Updates about scholarship opportunities

To begin, click on Application, Apply, or Complete to start filling out your general application.



3. Application Sections

Your application is divided into several sections. You must complete all of them before you can submit.

 **Reminder: Ask your references early so they have plenty of time. Double-check that they received the request email and follow up if needed.**

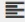
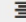

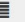

- You will need to provide a personal statement (maximum 1,000 words).

Tips for your essay:

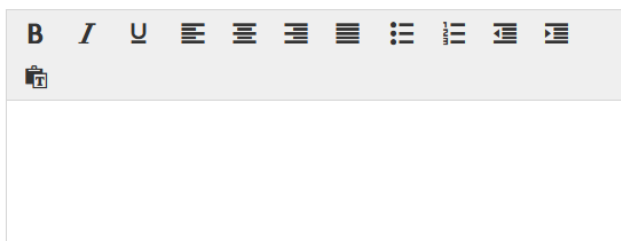
- **Share your story—what motivates you, challenges you’ve overcome, and your goals.**
- **Highlight academic achievements, community involvement, and career aspirations.**
- **Be clear, genuine, and specific.**

4. Submitting Your Application


- After you complete all sections, the Submit Application button (bottom right) will appear.
- Review the certification statement and click **Submit Application** and you’ll be redirected back to your Dashboard.

5. Checking Scholarship Matches

- Click the Scholarships tab to see which scholarships you qualify for.
- Some scholarships may require extra steps (such as answering an essay question or uploading documents).
- Click Complete to finish any follow-up tasks.

6. Final Steps

- Once you’ve completed all tasks, your Dashboard will show no pending items.
- At this point, your application is fully submitted!
